

Converting audio files using Sound Editor in Creator 6

Please Note: Due to the DRM settings in a Windows Media Audio file, Sound Editor cannot open them for editing. However, Sound Editor can convert other files formats to the WMA file format.

- 1. Open Sound Editor.
 - 1. Double click on the Easy CD & DVD Creator 6 icon on the desktop.
 - 2. Click on the Audio Central icon.
 - 3. On the bottom right hand side of the *Audio Central* window there are five icons in a row. Click on the fourth icon to open **Sound Editor**.
- Converting the audio file.

Note: Sound Editor is able to open and convert to the following file formats: RXS, WMA, WAV, MP3, OGG.

- 1. Click **File** on the top left hand corner of the window, then select **Open Track...**.
- 2. This will display the *Open Audio Track* window. Go to the location on your hard drive where the file is located and highlight it by left clicking on it, then click the **Open** button.
- 3. Click File on the top left hand corner of the window, then select Save track As...
- 4. A *Save As* window will appear. Choose the location on your hard drive where you want to save the file to and type in a file name.
- 5. Click the down arrow beside the *Save as type* option and choose the file format you want to convert the file to. If applicable, choose the appropriate options under the *Encoder* section.
- 6. Once you have selected all options, click on the Save button to save the file.
- 7. You will now have a new converted file at the location you specified.
