Problem: A ?video graphics overlay? message appears when a user tries to play a DVD using Cineplayer.

Resolution: Update video card drivers to the latest available that are WHQL Certified and support the Operating System, also setting to recommended screen resolutions and try disabling <u>DXVA</u> and <u>VMR</u> settings or closing whatever else is using the video overlay. Within Cineplayer, go to Settings > Video to disable/enable these settings.

- Go to Start -> Control Panel -> CinePlayer DVD Decoder Options (if you don't see it, click on Switch to Classic View at the left) -> Video tab, uncheck the box for Enable Video Mixing Renderer (VMR) Support and click on Apply then OK.
