## Checking the DirectX version in XP

- 1. Click the *Start* button, select **Run** and type "dxdiag" without quotation marks.
- Wait until the loading bar in the lower left has completed
- Click on the *Sound* tab. Under the *Driver* section ensure it says **Yes** beside *WHQL Logo'd*.
- Under *Notes* at the bottom of the screen, check to make sure you see **No Problems Found**.
- Click on the *Display* tab. Under the Driver section ensure it says **Yes** beside *WHOL Logo'd*.
- Under *Notes* at the bottom of the screen, check to make sure you see **No Problems Found**.
- Click on the *System* tab and click on **Save All Information.**If you need Roxio Support, please attach the saved *System Information* document to your ticket.

## Checking the DirectX version in Windows 7, Vista

- 1. Click the *Start* button, type "dxdiag" without quotation marks in the *Start Search* box.
- Wait until the loading bar in the lower left has completed.
- Click on the Sound tab. Under the Driver section ensure it says Yes beside WHQL Logo'd.
