Resetting VideoStudio Pro/ultimate X9.

Resetting VideoStudio Pro/Ultimate X9 to default settings requires renaming or removing a specific folder under the User Profile. This process resets the program library, so re-importing your videos, images or music files may be necessary afterwards.

To save the VideoStudio library:

- Click Settings
- ClickLibrary Manager
- Click Export Library...
- Select a destination folder or create one
- Click the **OK** button

To Import the VideoStudio Library

- Click Settings
- Click Library Manager
- Click Import Library...
- Select the destination folder that holds the exported library information
- Click the **OK** button

Before performing this procedure, please ensure that Corel® VideoStudio Pro/Ultimate X9 is not running.

On Windows 8 and 10:

- 1. On the keyboard, launch the **Run** box by pressing the Windows button then the letter R (Windows + R)
- 2. In the Open box, type %APPDATA% and press the enter key.
- 3. In the new window, find the Ulead Systems folder.
- 4. Open the **Ulead Systems** folder.
- 5. Open the **Corel VideoStudio Pro** folder.
- 6. There should be a folder named 19.0 here.
- 7. Rename 19.0 to 19.0_old.

On Windows Vista / 7:

- 1. Click on Start.
- 2. Click in the search box at the bottom of the Start menu.
- 3. Type in: %APPDATA% and press the enter key.

- 4. In the new window, find the **Ulead Systems** folder.
- 5. Open the Ulead Systems folder.
- 6. Open the **Corel VideoStudio Pro** folder.
- 7. There should be a folder named **19.0** here.
- 8. Rename 19.0 to 19.0_old.
- 9. Launch VideoStudio Pro/Ultimate X9.

Once the folder has been renamed, VideoStudio Pro X9 will now reset to its factory default settings when the program is launched.

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
