

No sound when recording with Sound Editor from an external device

Follow the listed procedure to make sure the correct sound card port is selected and not muted.

- 1. Verifying that the input port is selected.
 - 1. Double click on the **Volume** (speaker) icon on the bottom right hand side of the screen beside the time.
 - 2. Locate and left click on **Options** on the upper left hand corner of the window, then select **Properties**.
 - 3. Make sure there is a little dot beside the **Recording** option.
 - 4. Under the *Show the following volume controls* section ensure that the port that your external device is plugged into has a check mark beside it.
 - 5. Then click the **OK** button.
 - 6. In the volume control window make sure there is a check mark beside **Select** for the port that you external device is plugged into, and the volume setting is near the top.
- Verifying that the output device has volume.
 - 1. Locate and left click on **Options** on the upper left hand corner of the window, then select **Properties**.
 - 2. Make sure there is a little dot beside the **Playback** option.
 - 3. Under the *Show the following volume controls* section, ensure that the port of your external device is plugged into, has a check mark beside it, then click the **OK** button.
 - 4. In the *Volume Control* window, make sure there is NOT a check mark beside **Mute** for the port that your external device is plugged into, and the volume setting is near the top.
 - 5. Exit the *Recording Control* windows by clicking on the "X" in the top right hand corner of the screen. You should now be able to successfully record from your external device using Sound Editor.

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
