

CoreIDRAW: Unable to sign in and see the files in SharePoint drive from the Dashboard/Cloud dialog

• CorelDRAW Standard

In order to view and access the contents of a connected Microsoft SharePoint storage in the Dashboard (i.e., ?Save to Cloud? or ?Open from Cloud?) in CorelDRAW (Windows or Mac) or CorelDRAW.app users should have third-party cookies enabled in the browser, so the authentication process can work properly to sign you in. Some browsers disable third-party cookies by default.

How to enable third-party cookies

Google Chrome

- 1. Open the menu on the top right (three vertical dots) and select **Settings**. This will open Chrome Settings page.
- 2. Select **Privacy and Security** from the left-side navigation.
- 3. Select **Site Settings** in the center section
- 4. On the Site Settings screen, scroll down to Cookies and site data section and click on it.
- 5. Make sure that the **Block third-party cookies** setting is turned off

Mozilla Firefox

- 1. Open the menu on the top right (three horizontal lines) and select **Options**. This will open Firefox Options page.
- 2. Select **Privacy & Security** from the left-side navigation.
- 3. On the Browser Privacy screen, select the **Custom** option. Uncheck the checkbox next to **Cookies**

Microsoft Edge

- 1. Open the menu on the top right (three horizontal dots) and select **Settings**. This will open Edge Settings page.
- 2. Select **Cookies and site permissions** from the left-side navigation.
- 3. Click on the Manage and delete cookies and site data
- 4. Uncheck Block third-partycookies

Apple Safari

- 1. Open the Safari menu from the top-left corner and select Preferences
- 2. Go to the Privacy Tab and uncheck "Prevent cross-site tracking"
