

AfterShot Pro: Error on Ubuntu 17.04 / 17.10

AfterShot

Problem:

When downloading AfterShot Pro, if you select "Open" instead of "Save File" in your web browser, you may see an error stating:

Sorry, something went wrong

- E: Problem parsing Provides line
- E: Error occurred while processing aftershot3x64 (NewVersion2)
- E: Problem with MergeList /tmp/mozilla_username0/AfterShotPro3.deb
- E: The package lists or status file could not be parsed or opened.

Problem:

When installing AfterShot Pro 3 in Ubuntu 17.10 or 17.04, you may see an error stating that the dependencies could not be met.

Solution:

- 1. Click here to download a script
- 2. Open a terminal:
 - . Click on Activities in the upper right,
 - . Type: terminal
 - . Click on the Terminal icon.
- 3. In the terminal window, type: ~/Downloads/afterShot3Pro-Ubuntu_17.sh
- 4. Press Enter.
- 5. You may be prompted for your password so that the software can be installed.
- 6. The script will download and install AfterShot and any required packages.
