To test if this article applies to you:

- 1. Open a terminal window in Fedora
- 2. Run the following command: /usr/bin/AfterShot3X64
- 3. Look for ?This application failed to start because no Qt platform plugin could be initialized. Reinstalling the application may fix this problem? in the output.

To fix the issue:

You will need sudo permissions. Run the following command from the terminal Window: sudo yum install compat-openssl10-devel

To Test the fix:

When the command is complete AfterShot will launch normally.
